"Future History" Timeline

Note to my readers: Although it might not be obvious, there is a nexus between many of my books (but not all of them). The world-lines of the characters weave through and around a complex future history that has a fictional timeline running from the far past to the distant future. This list probably isn't complete (you can help me fill it in by reading all my books). The essential events and the books where they appear are as follows (events that are starred are not fiction):

226 million years ago: ETs Odri, Phumon, and Badja crash on Saturn's moon Helene (*Sing a Samba Galactica*)

65 million years ago: a later Odri plants his device in a Colorado cave (Evil Agenda)

1450: Deep Diver's first experience in zero g on the home world (novella "Flight from the Mother World," found in the short story collection *Pasodobles in a Quantum Stringscape*)

1503: Deep Diver-led Rangers head for New Haven to flee the nefarious Tali, ETs who are invading the mother world (novella "Flight from the Mother World," found in the short story collection *Pasodobles in a Quantum Stringscape*).

1607: Rangers settle New Haven (novella "Flight from the Mother World," found in the short story collection *Pasodobles in a Quantum Stringscape*)

1995: first extrasolar planet found*

2003: Odri's device is discovered in the Colorado cave (Evil Agenda)

2005: Cassini probe sends parachute probe to Titan*

2005: Data Quality Act – Boston Globe 8/28/05*

2014: Luxor Hotel in Las Vegas is bombed; assassination attempt on U.S. president during speech on Wall Street (*The Midas Bomb*). [Note from Steve: obviously this fictional universe is a parallel one. I wrote published the first edition of the book in 2009, so the events in the book are in that future, but the state of the Universe split into separate timeslines.]

2015-2018: "Chen and Castilblanco Series" #2-5: Major confrontation between U.S. authorities and cartel/terrorists/militia collaboration (*Angels Need Not Apply*); major black market arms dealers thwarted (*Teeter-Totter between Lust and Murder*); terrorist who kidnaps royal family members brought to justice (*Aristocrats and Assassins*); old Nazi using stolen painting to finance human trafficking and porn films thwarted (*The Collector*).

2016: BREXIT*. (Mentioned in *Rembrandt's Angel.*) [Note: the date is for Great Britain's vote to leave the EU. As of this writing, they're still figuring out how to do it. In my fictional timeline, the country leaves the EU.]

2017: Sweden, the last European holdout, changes its medical system because it can't afford a completely socialized system that cover all their citizens due to high prices attached to new drugs and techniques as well as the influx of immigrants from southern Europe. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2018: Esther Brookstone and Bastiann van Coevorden thwart neo-Nazis from taking over Europe (*Rembrandt's Angel*).

2019: Esther Brookstone and Bastiann van Coevorden have more adventures as they search for St. John the Divine's tomb. (*Son of Thunder*)

2019-2025: "Chen and Castilblanco Series" #6-7: The detectives stop a cruise ship takeover (*Family Affairs*), and they stop a plot to increase oil prices (*Gaia and the Goliaths*).

2019: Hale and Rivera vs. US Supreme Court decision. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2020: most HMOs have gone to multi-tier system where full medical coverage is only for the rich elites. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2030: *The Golden Years of Virginia Morgan* begins; assassination attempt on presidential candidate Sheila Remington thwarted.

2032: Sheila Remington elected to her first term (Soldiers of God).

2036: Sheila Remington elected to her second term (Soldiers of God)

November, 2037: Sheila Remington, campaigning for re-entering the space race with a slide showing the ice tides on Titan*, dies in a terrorist attack, leading to third war in the Middle East (starts 2038) (*Soldiers of God*).

2040-2050: steady increase in percentage of crimes due to the lucrative black market in body parts. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2044: third war in Middle East ends. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2048: John Fulton elected to his first term as U.S. president. (Mentioned in *Full Medical*.)

2051: Jon Lewis born (plays a major role in Part Two of Survivors of the Chaos).

2052: John Fulton elected to his second term as U.S. president (serves at the time of *Full Medical*).

May, 2053: major breakout at secret cloning center in Virginia (Full Medical).

2071: Johnny Holiday is murdered (Evil Agenda).

2072: Discovery of the bio-warfare plot (No Amber Waves of Grain).

December, 2077: Discovery of murdered graduate student in Rock Creek Park, D.C. (Soldiers of God).

March, 2078: Nukes interchanged between Venezuela and Colombia—Bogota, Caracas and Maracaibo are hit (*Soldiers of God*).

2095: Brent Mueller born (character all through the "Chaos Chronicles Trilogy").

2098: Jenny Wong born (character all through the "Chaos Chronicles Trilogy")

2111: Zebediah Lane born (character in Survivors of the Chaos).

2117: Billy Clark born (character in Survivors of the Chaos and Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2126: Chaos starts—the world moves through the social singularity. (Survivors of the Chaos)

2129: Four kids determine the origins of a mutant cat and thwart a conspiracy on the International Space Station (*The Secret Lab*).

May, 2132: Project Saturn Watch begins—halfway through the Chaos (Survivors of the Chaos)

July 4, 2132: Alien artifacts destroyed on Saturn's moon Helene (Survivors of the Chaos).

2133: Chaos ends, Eureka Ltd. begins.

2141: Gordon Takahashi born (character in Survivors of the Chaos and Sing a Zamba Galactica)

2143: Robot probes launched to various nearby star systems (important for *Survivors of the Chaos*).

2149: Cryosleep perfected (important for *Survivors of the Chaos*)

2153: Colonizing starship Leif Erikson leaves for Tau Ceti (Survivors of the Chaos)

2157: Colonizing starship Marco Polo leaves for δ Pavonis (*Survivors of the Chaos*)

2164: Colonizing starship Magellan leaves for 82 Eridani, and Billy Clark is stowaway (*Survivors of the Chaos*).

2217: Earth's Criminal Code established; becomes governing code of star colonies (*Survivors of the Chaos*).

2252: The Tali hordes begin invasion of Earth (Sing a Zamba Galactica)

2270: Battle of Sanctuary, δ Pavonis system (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2271: Magellan arrives at New Haven, 82 Eridani system (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2272: Physicist Annie Li born (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2275: New Haven learns of Earth invasion by Talis; engineer Ian Holst born (*Sing a Zamba Galactica*)

2288: New Haven learns of Sanctuary battle (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2353-4: first successful FTL flights from New Haven to Earth (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2505: Battle of Norway (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

2819: Treaty of New Haven signed forming ITUIP** (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

3018: Singer cures Swarm (Sing a Zamba Galactica).

3053: Asako Kobayashi saves the native Fistians on the planet Hard Fist (Secret of the Urns).

3071: Brent Mueller and Jenny Wong work hard to stop a psychotic industrialist from exploiting the metaverses and the ITUIP worlds. (*Come Dance a Cumbia...with Stars in Your Hand!*)

4000+: Stories about the starship Brendan's medical officer, Dr. Carlos Obregon (*Pasodobles in a Quantum Stringscape* and *Fantastic Encores!*).

4000+: Kaushal and friends save his planet from a brutal theocracy (Rogue Planet).

4000+: Della Dos Toros and friends thwart a Psi-Corps plot to take over ITUIP (Mind Games)
